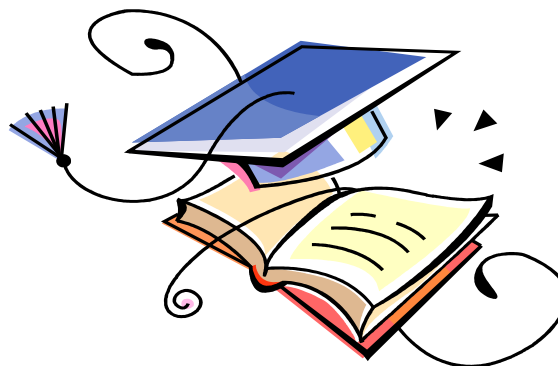
Boarders may return after 6:30 pm.
