Primary Responsibilities

- Ensure the safety and well-being of all campers.
- Teach and develop course curricula aligned to learning standards, create lesson plans with defined learning objectives, establish a safe and nutrition class environment that encourages exploration and risk taking.
- Maintain attendance records
- Communicate proactively with camp administrators concerning student engagement and performance.
- Supervise activities while ensuring student safety at all times, giving direction appropriate to the activity, and modeling good behavior and citizenship.
- Must be able to commit to the full six-week program.
- Additional State mandated orientations and meetings are also required.

Minimum Qualifications

- Professional experience in subject area. Bachelor's degree in subject area preferred.
- At least two years of experience as a classroom teacher preferred.
- Ability to collaborate with faculty, staff, and administrators.
- Ability to communicate clearly and effectively, verbally and in writing.
- Strong organizational skills, attention to detail, and follow-through.
- Positive attitude, flexible approach, and a sense of humor.
