Camp Description Under Covid Restrictions

- Six-week program beginning June 28 and ending August 6 from 9 AM to 4 PM. There will be no beforecare or aftercare available.
- All campers must be full time. Weekly options will not be available this summer in an effort to keep the roster consistent to comply with social distancing requirements.
- There will be a maximum of 10 to 15 campers per group. Large gatherings will be limited. Social distance and masking will be applied.
- Groups will be set up around grade ranges and schedule choice. No individual class choices or changing of concentrations will be allowed. Classes may be modified for age appropriateness.
- Once groups are established, campers will remain with their groups throughout the summer. Those campers wishing to be in the same group must choose the same concentration. Grouping requests will be accommodated if possible, but are not guaranteed.
- There will be no live performances. The year-end theater and dance productions will be recorded and distributed to families.
- Sports and physical activities can run without physical contact. For example, basketball will be limited to skill building and shooting games. A choice of swimming or ice skating will be offered.
- There will be no transportation provided.
- There will be no off-campus trips.

Safety/Health Procedures

A description of the Covid-19 health and safety protocols are outlined below. Please read the details carefully. We are taking a multi-layered approach based on guidance from New York State and the CDC as we do our best to mitigate the risks of transmission on school grounds, but please keep in mind that there is no such thing as eliminating the risk entirely.

- All campers, faculty, and staff are required to wear masks. Socially distanced mask breaks will be offered regularly.
- Social distancing rules will be in effect.

- Campers will be required to wash/sanitize their hands BEFORE and AFTER each activity.
- Surfaces, tools, equipment, and toys will be disinfected between classes.
- Parents will have to agree to partner with camp leadership in terms of monitoring children's health. Campers with a fever of 100F+ or with other symptoms will not be allowed to attend camp.
- Sanitizer/Hand Washing stations will be available.
- Our food service will prepare, package, and distribute lunches. We will have options for campers with dietary restrictions.
- Signs will be posted directing campers to practice good hygiene and social distancing.
- Hallways will be made one directional when possible.
- For camper drop-off and pick-up, parents will be required to stay in their cars. Procedure details will be outlined in a separate email.
